

The four-semester, full-time MSW program is outlined below. It requires 60 credit hours, and each student completes 300 hours of field work over three semesters for a total of 900 hours.

ADVANCED STANDING

Applicants who have earned a Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) degree within the past five years from a CSWE-accredited program may be eligible for our Advanced Standing program, enabling them to earn an MSW in three semesters of full-time study or six semesters of part-time study.

PART-TIME

The part-time MSW program, available online only, requires from six to nine credit hours per semester over eight semesters, for a total of 60 credit hours. Each student completes 150 hours of field work over six semesters for a total of 900 hours.
