

MASTER OF SOCIAL WORK PART-TIME

The part-time MSW program, which is only available online, requires 8 semesters over 32 consecutive months for a total of 60 credit hours. Each student completes 12 practicum education hours a week for six semesters, for a total of 900 hours. The program's curriculum is outlined below.
