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IX. CURRENT BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF TEACHING AND RESEARCH INTERESTS

A. Research Interests:

1. Family Practice; Interests focus on treatment outcome research along with training community service providers in state-of-the-art evidence-based practice methods.
2. Addictions: Interests focus on treatment outcome research.
3. Inter-partner Violence: Interests focus on developing new methods to assess and treat those demonstrating this problem.
4. Mindfulness: Examining the educational impact of training students in mindfulness practices. -Carried out mindfulness training for students volunteering to participate. Approximately 20 students took part in this training program. The training program was also evaluated, following IRB approval, and I am currently concluding the intervention facet of the program.
